•Withdrawal of race numbers and last-minute registrations:

•Races Start:

Tweenz MiniTrail - 900 m (6 – 8 ans) **10h00**

Tweenz MiniTrail - 1600 m **(9 – 12 ans) 10h15**

La GranDucale - 34 km 10h40

Le Trail des Forts - 27 km 11h00


Dans les pas de Mélusine - 18 km Individuel & team-run pour 3 co-équipiers (5km > 6km > 7km) 11h50-12h00

Les Traces de Vauban - 13 km **12h10-12h20-12h30**

•For team-run participants:


The 1st relay will start at 11h50 and 12h00 from the Cité Judiciaire. The 2nd relay runner (6 km) will take the Bisserweg relay point (take the lift at the Cité Judiciaire to go down to the Grund and take the Münster bridge and turn right into rue Bisserweg, 200 metres away).

The 1st runner will return to the Cité Judiciaire by taking the lift in the opposite direction.



The 3rd relay runner (7 km) relay point: rue du Fort Dumoulin (take the lift at the Cité Judiciaire, to go down to the Grund and take the Münster bridge and turn left into rue Munster, and rue de Tréves at the INS).

The 2nd relay runner will return to the Cité Judiciaire in the opposite direction by taking the lift again.



•Timing:

Your time will be displayed as soon as you arrive. You'll also find the time on our website the next day www.dkv-urbantrail.lu

•Refreshment points:

Refreshment points will be set up along the course every 5km. The feed station at the finish is in the village trail next to the big tent.

PLEASE NOTE: Please bring a collapsible, reusable cup with you on your run!

As we're concerned about the environment, we're no longer supplying disposable cups at the various refreshment points!

Prize giving ceremony starting at 14h00 :

The top 3 men and women in each race will receive a cup and a cash prize. To be eligible, they must be present at the prize-giving ceremony. Podium for the first veterans (V1, V2, V3, V4, V5) men and women in each race. All children taking part in the Spuerkeess Tweenz MiniTrails will receive a medal.

•Catering :

Catering stands (food and drink) are available at the Village Trail in the Cité Judiciaire.

•Clothes drop-off & changing rooms:

Clothes drop-off is possible at the Village Trail in the Cité Judiciaire.

ATTENTION: please use the "Securitec" bag given to you with your race number to store your personal items/clothing! We will not be able to accept any other bags, objects or containers at the left-luggage office!

The organisers accept no responsibility for loss or theft. Please do not leave any valuables in your personal belongings. Changing rooms will be available at the Village Trail in the Cité Judiciaire.

•Showers:

Showers are available at the Badeanstalt (12, rue des Bains; 600 m walk from the Cité Judiciaire) on presentation of your race number at the entrance.

•Toilets:

There are toilets in the Village Trail at the Cité Judiciaire and public toilets either near the "Gëlle Fra" or at the exit by taking the lift to the Grund.

•Weather:

In order to make the most of your participation in the **DKV-UrbanTrail** please check **the weather** forecast before setting off and make sure you have the appropriate clothing.

•Security:

Please note that this is not a closed circuit, so obey the highway code and treat each other with respect. Anyone injured must stop another runner or call for an ambulance.

You can also ask the nearest refreshment station to take you back to the Cité Judiciaire.

•Kids:

Children taking part in the DKV-UrbanTrail remain the responsibility of their parent or guardian at all times.

Please note that you are taking part at your own risk and must ensure that you are able to do so safely.

•Car parks:


Parking Knuedler (11 Rue Notre Dame ; 400 m walking distance from Cité Judiciaire)

Parking Théâtre (13, place du Théâtre ; 700 m walking distance from Cité Judiciaire)

Parking Monterey (37 Av. Monterey; 700 m walking distance from Cité Judiciaire)

Parking du Glacis (21 Allée Scheffer ; 1700 m walking distance from Cité Judiciaire)

As a general rule, try to use public transport as much as possible to get to the DKV-UrbanTrail.



Public Transports (Free):

Use public transport (free) as much as possible to get to the Cité Judiciaire.

By bus:

There are many buses to the Roosevelt and Hamilius bus stops, which are 100m away respectively 500 m from the Village Trail with a cadence of (+- every 15 minutes)

By train:


Several trains stop at Luxembourg station. From there, the tram and several bus lines stop just a few minutes' walk from the Village Trail.

By tram:

The tram serves several car parks. The Hamilius stop is 500 m from the Village Trail. (+- every 7 minutes).
